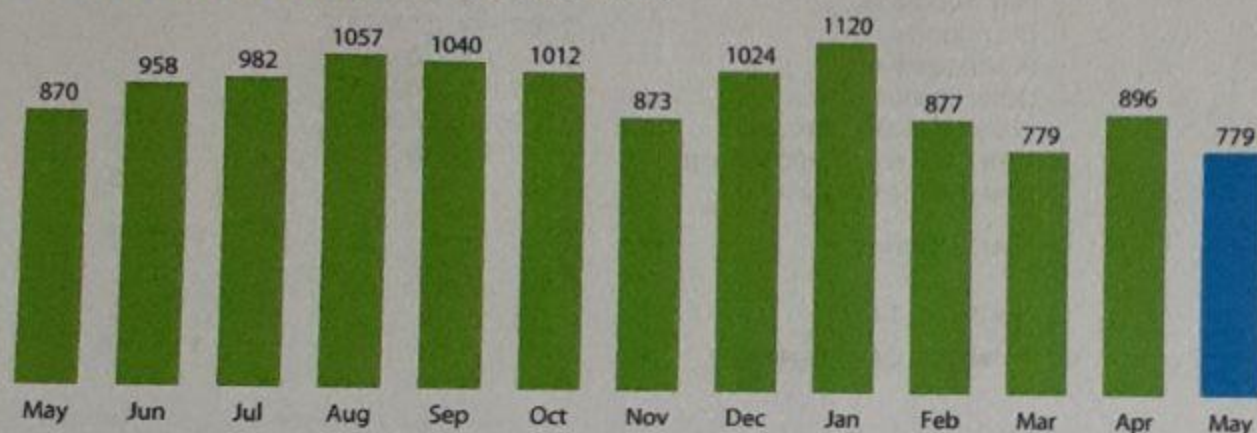

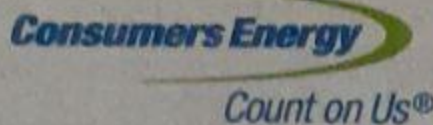


**If you smell natural gas.**

Visit [www.MISSDIG.org](http://www.MISSDIG.org) or call 8-1-1 to have underground lines marked. We clear our lines within our easements. The clearance distance and our maintenance schedule follow safety standards for the voltage and tree type. We clean-up debris from our planned work. Debris from other requested and emergent work is your property, and we are unable to clean it up. If a tree or branch is causing pressure on an electric wire, stay at least 25 feet away from the wire or anything touching it and call us at 800-477-5050.
